



Scannable Code

This is the QR code you scan. There are lots of codes on the labels, but your scanner will only take this one.



What part of the Sort Assist Label is highlighted?



Zone Letter

Oversized packages are sorted by zone letter to reflect the order of deliveries on route.



What part of the Sort Assist Label is highlighted?



Driver Aid Number

The numbers are sequenced to reflect the order of delivery, with the lowest numbers being first.

They are an important reference when organizing packages for delivery.
